Above are the most recent achievements for young Scott and the best result to date was finishing in the top 4 players in the world in the under 13 years age groups at the British Junior Open in Sheffield England in January 2011. This is an outstanding achievement and the best result for a male squash player from New Zealand in many years. Along with the above achievements Scott has won every NZ title available in the under 11, 13 and 15 age groups including the North and South island titles and the NZ national titles. Scott has been a part of Squash Wellington Development Squads and is currently a member of our Elite Junior Squad. He also made our nationals team to represent at the National Teams Event in Auckland 2011 which is an under 19 squad.



As mentioned Scotty is one of the best players to come out of New Zealand in a very long time and our aim is to ensure that he is able to maintain and improve his current ranking on the world squash scene by helping him attend international tournaments on a regular basis.

To be the best you must play and beat the best and that is why Scotty MUST be given these opportunities if he is to reach his goal to CLIMB TO THE TOP OF THE WORLD.

Scott's parents have worked their butts off over the years to help him attend some of the tournaments he needs to attend but we are now seeking support to help him attend more events which will help him to achieve his goal. Scott has proven that he is amongst the top players in his age group in the world and with financial support we could have a world champion in the near future.

Scott's tournament schedule for 2012

This year Scott and his coach focused on quality play rather than quantity. During the months of January to March 2012 Scott will be focusing on fitness and strengthening programs that will help him to endure hard games.

Scott's first local tournaments of the year will be focused on getting Scott to A grade before March when he turns 14. This will be a new NZ record for the youngest A grade player, since Glen Wilson, to reach A grade.

The plan is for Scott to play his first International of the season, in Sydney to play in the Australian Junior series from 16 to 25 April. This consists of two tournaments over the nine days. He will play against some of the top Australian U15 and U17 juniors.

Scott will then play in the Malaysian Milo series in Kuala Lumpur and the Penang Junior open from May 28 to June 13.

Scott plans to play in the Australian junior Nationals again in September 2012. He placed 3rd in the 2011 Australian Junior nationals.

Scott is planning to go to the UK in December 2012 to January 2013 to test his capabilities in the Under 15s in Scotland and Edinburgh. After turning 13 on March 5 2011 Scott's ranking of #4 in the U13s moved to #14 in the U15s.

To be able to send Scott back to the UK at the end of next year, funding will play a critical part in doing this. The cost for the Australian, Malaysian and UK missions will be around \$18,000. However securing funding early could see that reduce to \$15,000

Scott will continue to play in the NZ national tournament series throughout 2012 in the U17s, 3 years earlier than his eligibility.

His coach, Nick Mita, has pledged his support for Scott and will attend these tournaments with Scott. His parents will take a back seat role and focus on getting Scott (and Nick) where Scott needs to be.

We look forward to everyone's continued support for Scott.
